



# The SLYRS Bavarian Single Malt Whisky Distillery

#### Tradition, passion and unique Bavarian character

As a whisky pioneer from Upper Bavaria, SLYRS has set the standard for whisky know-how since 1999.

Distilled in the traditional way and aged to perfection in new casks made from American white oak, the SLYRS single malt whisky 'Classic', with its exceptionally mild and delightfully malty character and distinctive fruity aromas, has been delighting whisky lovers far beyond Germany's borders since 1999.

Driven by a deep passion and love for the product, Hans Kemenater, master distiller at SLYRS, with his young team of trained whisky distillers and brewers work every day to create the unmistakeable SLYRS character.

With an innovative and adventurous spirit, he and his team create high-quality whisky compositions whose appeal extends far beyond connoisseurs. Our SLYRS Single Malt Whiskies feature regularly at renowned international award and tasting events such as the World Whiskies Awards in London, the San Francisco Spirit Competition and the Hong Kong International Wine & Spirit Competitions.







#### Malting barley:

We use malting barley that is grown and processed into malt in the Munich area. The grain is steeped and then germinated in malting boxes, where the germination process is interrupted at the right point by a 'curing' or drying process. The grain has now been converted into malt. Once the malt arrives at the distillery, it undergoes a series of stringent laboratory tests. If the malt is accepted, it can be milled and mixed with water to create a mash.

#### Mashing:

The mash is heated to 62 °C and 72 °C. At these temperatures, the natural enzymes contained in the malt convert the starch into maltose. After the wort separation and cooling stages, the wort is fermented with yeast in a temperature-controlled environment. This is the best way to preserve the flavours. In this process, the maltose produces alcohol and carbonic acid. After a fermentation period of around a week, the fermented wort can be distilled off.

#### **Fermentation**

The specific whisky yeast used by SLYRS converts the maltose into alcohol and fermentation by-products. The fermented wort has an alcohol content of 7.5 to 8% ABV. This process is a vital part of our SLYRS DNA.

#### Distillation:

The first step involves creating a low wine in copper stills. These produce a distillate with an alcohol content of around 30%. This low wine is then distilled a second time to produce what is called a 'middle cut' with 70% ABV.

The traditional double distillation process preserves all of the important aromatic substances in the malt. Distillation in small copper stills and the careful separation of the head and tail fractions results in a highly aromatic, smooth and mild distillate.



#### Storage and ageing:

The heart section of the distillate is now diluted with fresh mountain spring water to the cask strength of 55% ABV and filled into the casks. We age the fresh distillate in barrique casks made from American white oak with a volume of 225 litres. These are heavy-toasted and help create the perfect flavour of the single malt.

After an ageing period of three to six years, some of our SLYRS whisky is transferred to well-travelled casks, including from Bodegas Tradición/Jerez, for special finishes. This creates premium rarities with their own special flavour.

It's worth mentioning that our pride and joy, SLYRS Aged 12 Years, is aged in traditional casks of our own.

The SLYRS Mountain Edition also rests in American white oak casks in our storehouse at the top of Mount Stümpfling. It is aged at an altitude of 1,501 metres in the purest mountain air and under extreme temperature fluctuations.

Raw material sourced from the region, gentle production and a long ageing process in the ideal casks made from American white oak turn this classic into an outstanding single malt that is a real delight when sampled neat.

The Fifty One is a secret single malt blend, aged for different lengths of time in casks previously used to store sherry, port or Sauternes. The name 'Fifty One' refers to the characterful 51% ABV.

This is a cuvée in a class of its own in every sense. That's because this German whisky is not only aged in normal casks, but also in casks that previously contained port, sherry or Sauternes. This blend of different flavours really comes into its own thanks to the whisky's comparatively high alcohol content, which is why the SLYRS Fifty One is best served neat at room temperature.

Colour: Darker golden yellow

Aroma: Prune and roast chestnut, with moss and spruce as

well as a hint of chocolate.

Flavour: Tangy herbs with added cloves, nutty and fresh on

the palate.

Finish: Long and intense, slightly dry.

#### SLYRS SLYRS Single Malt Whisky Aged 12 Years 43% ABV

Even the SLYRS Classic is so well aged after spending three to six years in the cask that it delights aficionados and connoisseurs and has received numerous awards. Consequently, the 12-year-old version is absolutely sublime with its fully developed flavour – making it a veritable masterpiece for those special occasions in the life of a true connoisseur.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Clear and golden yellow

**Aroma:** Mildly aromatic notes such as vanilla, caramel, honey and cinnamon dominate, punctuated by the scent of ripe pears and apricots. There is also a discernible hint of smoke, wood, nutmeg and tarragon.

**Flavour:** Pleasing soft structure with complex aromas of orange and salted caramel.

**Finish:** Long and complex with nicely embedded flavours of ripe fruit.

## Mountain **Edition**

#### **SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Mountain Edition 45% ABV

How a distillate that is meant to become whisky actually develops depends not only on its ingredients and the cask in which it is stored, but also on the influence of the landscape in which it is aged. Even laypeople can quickly smell and taste the difference between, say, a single malt whisky aged in the Scottish Highlands, where the air is scented with herbs and flowers, and one aged in casks stored on an island near the sea. Let us assume that the distillate is aged in the SLYRS distillery in Schliersee-Neuhaus, which is situated 784 metres above sea level and has a temperate climate of 16.3 °C on average. And now let us assume that part of this distillate (50 casks to be exact) is aged at an altitude of 1,501 metres in fresh, pure mountain air, and is subjected to temperature fluctuations of up to 60 °C for a period of five years. This is precisely what happens with SLYRS whisky that is ultimately bottled as the Mountain Edition. This authentic Bavarian 'highlander', aged at the top of Mount Stümpfling in the Mangfall Mountains, is very much the 'peak of indulgence' for fans of a most unusual single malt whisky.



#### TASTING NOTE:

Colour: Bright golden yellow

Aroma: Bourbon vanilla, caramel, toasted almonds.

Flavour: Intense and aromatic, dry with light peppery notes.


Finish: Lingering, slightly smoky with a fruity sweetness.



## The variety of SLYRS flavours

The SLYRS world map – where do our casks come from?

It is no longer a secret that SLYRS makes many unique treasures. For some time, our product range has also included limited edition, premium single malts that are finished in second-hand casks of various origins. New destinations are added every year. During the ageing period, these casks' fine aromas enter the whisky and give it its special, characteristic and aromatic flavour.





#### SLYRS Single Malt Whisky Pedro Ximénez Finish 46% ABV

Pedro Ximénez is a sherry variety made from ripe white grapes with an exquisitely fruity smell and taste. The Palomino grape is a classic sherry grape. It is allowed to dry thoroughly, resulting in a high sugar content when the sherry is made. Finishing in casks that previously contained this exceptional sherry gives the whisky full-bodied fruity flavours that provide for a mellow finish. This malt is a real treat when served slightly below room temperature.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Dark honey

Aroma: Fruity with winter aromas such as dried plums and

berries.

Flavour: Pleasantly balanced with a sweet and aromatic note

that complements the whisky flavour smoothly.

Finish: Smooth, long on the palate with a hint of raisin.





#### **SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Oloroso Cask Finish 46% ABV

The Oloroso sherry variety is a fortified white wine from Andalusia. It leaves behind wonderful notes of fruit and wood in its ageing casks (450–500 litres). The SLYRS Bavarian single malt refilled into these casks then has roughly a year to absorb these flavours from the wood. Oloroso sherry is a very dry variety that gives the whisky subtle leathery and earthy notes. This unique spirit reveals its flavour to greatest effect when sampled and drunk just below room temperature.

#### **SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Port Cask Finish 46% ABV

Port is extremely popular due to its powerful fruity note. The strict regulations governing its production and the closely monitored minimum storage period of three years make this wine from the upper Douro Valley and its deep tributary valleys a mouth-watering speciality. This also benefits our SLYRS single malt whisky, which matures for up to nine months in tawny port casks. Served just below room temperature, the SLYRS Port Cask Finish tastes delightfully fresh and summery.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Sparkling honey yellow

Aroma: Slightly dry notes accompanied by the full scent of

nuts and dried fruit.

Flavour: Strong and complex, with tobacco, leather and subtle

roast flavours that gradually develop on the palate.

Finish: Smooth, long and multifaceted.

#### Tasting note:

**Colour:** Beautiful brown tones with copper-red colouring

**Aroma:** Aromatic and fruity with the scent of red berries, caramel and vanilla.

Flavour: Complex.

Finish: Complex and harmonious.



#### **SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Sauternes Cask Finish 46% ABV

As it ages, the famous white wine from the Bordeaux region develops a relatively full-bodied sweet flavour that is unrivalled. Sauternes wines are created with the help of a fungus called noble rot that grows on the grapes and increases their sugar content while reducing their water content. The mature SLYRS single malt is transferred to its ageing casks, where it is enriched over the course of 14 months with the extraordinary flavour of the special Sauternes wine. The result of this unusual combination is best appreciated if the SLYRS Sauternes Cask Finish is served neat or slightly cooled.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Sparkling honey yellow

Aroma: The typical SLYRS aroma combines with a hint of cit-

rus and fresh notes.

Flavour: Light and fruity, summer fresh with vanilla and honey

notes.

Finish: Long with beautifully spicy notes.



#### **SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Rum Cask Finish 46% ABV

After ageing for roughly half a decade in casks of American white oak, the single malt whisky is refilled into casks that were previously used to age rum from the island of Jamaica, which is renowned for its sugar cane. Jamaica rum generally has a full-bodied and aromatic flavour. Before it is bottled, it ages for several months in a wooden cask, which is used later on for refilling SLYRS malt whisky. SLYRS also uses casks that previously contained rhum agricole (made from sugar cane – not from molasses as is usually the case!) from the Caribbean island of Martinique for its whisky finish. Over a sufficiently long ageing period, the whisky also takes on the typical rum flavours to become a true masterpiece of the Bavarian whisky specialists. Tip: Best enjoyed neat.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Medium to dark amber colour.

Aroma: Delicious bouquet of caramel, beeswax and cedar wood,

with malty notes and a hint of camomile.

**Flavour:** Opening with vanilla flavours, gradually intensifying to roast flavours with notes of orange, honey and a pinch of lovage.

Finish: Long and full-bodied with subtle flavours of wood and raisin.



**SLYRS** Single Malt Whisky Marsala Cask Finish 46% ABV

The liqueur wine named after the Sicilian port of Marsala was originally fortified to preserve it while it was transported by ship to England. 'Fortifying' means adding distilled alcohol to the grape mash while it is fermenting. This is done to halt the fermentation process and preserve the residual sweetness of the grapes. This finish variant shows just how well the fruity notes of this liqueur wine combine with a whisky made from the finest barley. After being stored for three years in casks made of American white oak, the malt is refilled into casks that were previously used to age Marsala. Inside these casks, the fruity flavours of the wine enter the malt whisky and combine with its malty notes.

#### **Tasting note:**

Colour: Dark amber with copper tone

**Aroma:** Ripe strawberries and redcurrants, slightly sweet. **Flavour:** The flavour of freshly cooked jam and warming nut-

meg.

Finish: Long, with winey and floral notes.



#### SLYRS Single Malt Whisky Madeira Cask Finish 46% ABV

Madeira is a dessert wine named after the Portuguese island on which it is produced. It belongs to the 'fortified' wines, which means that alcohol – generally brandy – is added to it during the fermentation phase. This stops the fermentation process because yeast cells cannot survive an alcohol content of 16% ABV or more. This results in a wine with high levels of residual sweetness, which can then age to perfection in casks. These casks are used later on to store SLYRS whisky that has already been aged for four to five years in conventional casks made from American white oak. During a finishing time of almost two years, the malt absorbs the fruity, light notes of this fine wine to create a unique symphony of flavours. Drunk neat, the Madeira Cask Finish is a genuine delight and a superb accompaniment to sweet desserts.

#### **Tasting note:**

Colour: Medium-bright amber

Aroma: Pleasant scent of beeswax, pineapple with cedar

wood and a hint of camomile.

**Flavour:** Dry with a smooth mouthfeel.

Finish: Lingering notes of roast flavours, honey and bay leaf.



#### SLYRS Single Malt Whisky Amontillado Cask Finish 46% ABV

After being stored in the traditional way in new oak casks, the SLYRS single malt whisky acquires its finish over 11 months in the original Amontillado cask. We source these casks from the famous Bodegas Tradición (Jerez, Spain). These valuable casks, which are up to 50 years old, are used for our SLYRS aged in sherry casks. It has a golden yellow colour in the glass. The aroma contains hints of ripe apples, vanilla and green hazelnuts. Intense, aromatic nutty flavour. In the finish, it has a slightly salty note on the palate and a long and intense aftertaste.

#### Tasting note:

Colour: Sparkling amber

Aroma: Dried fruit and cedar wood notes with a hint of

camomile.

Flavour: Intense, aromatic, full-bodied bouquet of nuts and

tobacco.

Finish: Dry with a slightly salty note on the palate, long and

intense aftertaste.









**SLYRS** Bavarian RYE Whisky 41% ABV


Immigrants from Europe introduced rye to America more than 300 years ago. This cereal flourished there and became the ingredient for the original American whisky, which was initially only a speciality of the north-eastern USA. SLYRS managing director and master distiller Hans Kemenater, travelled with Anton Stetter, co-founder of the SLYRS distillery, for several weeks through the places of origin of rye whisky to learn as much as possible about this special type of 'water of life'. This knowledge was then incorporated into the meticulous development of a Bavarian rye, which was led by master brewer Philip Zollner, who also belongs to the SLYRS team. The 'ancient Bavarian grain' rye produces a sweet malt. As the dominant ingredient of the mash, it is complemented perfectly by the pleasing bouquets of the two 'minority grains' barley and wheat. The three-grain mash characterised by the rye majority produces a whisky that differs clearly from the SLYRS Bavarian single malt, which also makes it all the more interesting to try. Sample it neat and slightly cooled and you'll embark on a safari for the senses!



## Horse's Neck

- 6 cl RYE whisky
- 2 dashes of Angostura bitters
- Ginger ale

Put some ice cubes into the tumbler. Add RYE whisky and two dashes of Angostura bitters. Top up with ginger ale.





## Old Fashioned

- 6 cl RYE whisky
- 1 cl sugar syrup
- 3 dashes of Angostura bitters
- Orange zest

Fill a tumbler with ice. Pour in RYE whisky, syrup and Angostura bitters, and stir for around 1 minute. Strain into a tumbler filled with fresh ice. Twist a piece of orange zest over the glass to express the oils, and add it as a garnish.




